- Timing: All track events are scheduled to be electronically timed.
- **Text messages** no races can be entered via text message.
- Withdrawal All athletes who need to withdraw must do so before the event via the relevant booking website. Failure to notify the organiser will result in a ban from further events.
- Athletes will need to supply their EA registration number.
- 5000m If there are sufficient entries two races will be organised, with the first race starting at the advertised start time. The second race will follow immediately afterwards.

Sutcliffe Series Winners

- o £100 prizes for top senior male and female 800m/1500m athlete.
- o Finish with a top 10 time in either 800m or 1500m to gain points.
- Male and female athlete with most points from two out of three events, from different meetings wins £100.
- o Top time = 10 points. 10th best time =1 point.
- Any 800/1500m race qualifies.
- Where two or more athletes have same total, prize is shared.
- Only one race from each meeting allowed.
